

What's it about?



Everything you need to know about The Overall




At Jönköping University (JU) there is a vibrant unique culture, also known as the ovve-culture. This has become an integral part of the student life at JU. The ovve, shortened term for overall, holds a special significance during events such as the kick-off or at Akademien (AKA).

You will see overalls in different colors running around the university campus. Each faculty at JU is associated with its own unique color, which is reflected in the overalls worn by students from that faculty. When you see students wearing their overall you can see how many different programs JU offers.

When you receive your overall, you become part of the ovve-culture at Jönköping University. This comes with a special ISA-patch and other fun patches which are meant to be affixed on your overall after the overall ceremony. Next to this, you will also find a patch stating your program of study. Each academic program has its own color to showcase the program you are studying. To further enhance the visual representation of your program, you will also receive two sets of ribbons in the color of your program. These ribbons are to be placed on the outside of each leg, running parallel to the seam.

Overall Rules



Be aware to follow these rules when it comes to your Ovve

You are **not** allowed to wash your overall in the washer. You can only wash your overall when you are wearing it. So jump in the lake or under the shower while you are in it.

You are **not** ever allowed to write on your own overall, only on others'.

Before you attend the overall ceremony you have to wear the overall completely. Once you have completed the overall ceremony you are allowed to tie the sleeves and you wear the overall only halfway up. You are also not allowed to glue your patches on until after your overall ceremony.

The kick-off patch has to placed on your right leg above the knee

The patches that are most important to you, from events you liked the best or associations you have joined, are supposed to be affixed near your "holiest regions".

You will receive a JSApatch and a patch that represents the programme you follow when you buy your overall package. These patches have a designated spot on your ovve. The JSA-patch has to be placed on the upper part of your **left** leg. The program patch has to be placed on the upper part of your right leg and is supposed to be higher on the leg than the program patch.

If you have patches from events or sittnings you did not attend, you should glue it **upside down** on your ovve.

If you want someone else's patch, you can only get it by **biting** it off the ovve.

Akademien is the student club that is open every Wednesday from 21:00 until 02.00. Every Aka you wear the overall, so you don't have to think about what to wear. Easy right?

Akademien

The nightclub exclusive for students. Here we party every Wednesday from 21:00 to 02:00. The final call of the evening is always the song Stad I Ljus that we sing together. Best part about Aka? It is cheap and you get to wear your ovve!

Sittning

An event with food and entertainment. Usually it has a theme and you need to purchase tickets roughly one week before the event (queues can get really long!).

Fadder

The Fadders (students at JIBS) play a crucial role in your kick-off. They are the dedicated guides who ensure you have a memorable experience. During kick-off your Fadders will serve as your closest form of guidance and support system.

Jubel

The student pub at Jönköping University. You find Jubel in the JIBS building and is open every Wednesday from 16:00 - 20:00, making it the perfect place to pre-party before going to Aka.

Stad i Ljus

This is a traditional song amongst students and holds a special place in the student life as a source of inspiration, motivation, and a soundtrack to the memorable moments that shape the university experience. When you hear this song at the end of your Aka night, you know it's the end of the night.

Zero

A student with zero credits, meaning that this student has not yet earned any academic credits and therefore also called a new student.

Spex

A funny performance carried out during kick-off events or sittnings

The social committee of JSA, responsible for organizing the kick-off for the business school students.



Arranges international business trips and hosts events related to business and travel



Working towards a more sustainable environment at JIBS


